**Note:**

- The fees as approved is the maximum fees that can be charged and recovered from the students by the Institutes/Colleges mentioned above. The term 'Fees' has been defined u/s. 2(g) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (hereinafter referred as 'Act of 2015'). The fees as approved include tuition fee, library fee, gymkhana fee, examination fee, development fee or amount payable for any curricular or co-curricular activities, laboratory

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- fee, information brochure fee, and any other amount collected from the students, by whatsoever name called, and accepted in whichever manner, that is made payable to a Private Professional Educational Institution, for whatever purpose, by any candidate admitted to a professional course in any such Institution, but excludes any charges payable towards the use of any optional hostel accommodation, mess charges, and students Insurance fees.
2. Any amount accepted, recovered or charged by Unaided Institutions in cash or kind, directly or indirectly in excess or over and above the fees approved by the Fees Regulating Authority amounts to an Act of 'Profiteering' as defined u/s. 2(s) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 and the Management running such Institutions shall be liable for penalty as provided u/s. 20 (1) of the said Act of 2015. The amount of penalty to be payable may extend to twice the amount taken in excess of the fees as determined by the Fees Regulating Authority.
  3. During the course of enquiry, if it is found that Unaided Institution has charged the fees in excess of the fees approved by the Authority then such fees is liable to be returned to the concerned student/s.
  4. On repetition of contravention and irregularity, the name of the Institution shall be recommended for the withdrawal of affiliation or approval from the concerned Authority by the Fees Regulating Authority in the exercise of powers conferred u/s 20(5) of the said Act of 2015.
  5. As provided u/s 20(6) of the said Act of 2015 if the offence or irregularity under the provisions of said Act of 2015 or rules made under is found to be committed by the Management, for the purpose, who, at the time when the offence or irregularity was committed, was in charge of, and responsible to, the management for the conduct of the business of the management, as well as the management, shall be deemed to be guilty of the offence and shall be proceeded against and punished accordingly.
  6. **As provided u/s. 14(4) of the said Act of 2015, every Unaided Institution shall display on its notice board, the course-wise fees as approved by the Fees Regulating Authority and on its website in Marathi and English, provided that, in case of linguistic minority institutions, the display shall also be in the language of the minority to which such institution belongs and shall be binding on the students and the institutions. Non-compliance of section 14 (4) of said Act of 2015, the Institution shall liable for penal action u/s. 20 of the said Act of 2015.**


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
7. As provided u/s. 14(5) of the said Act of 2015, no Institution shall collect fee amounting to more than one - year fee from a candidate in an academic year and collection of fees for more than one year in an academic year shall be construed as collection of capitation fee and such institution shall be liable to be proceeded against.
8. As provided u/s. 14(6) of the said Act of 2015, the fees approved and communicated by the Fees Regulating Authority shall be applicable in respect of the candidate who is admitted to the unaided institution in that academic year and shall not be revised till the completion of the course of such student in the concerned institution. Non-compliance of section 14(6) of said Act of 2015, the institution shall liable for penal action u/s. 20 of the said Act of 2015.
9. The students and/or their parents may lodge a complaint against the Institution to the Fees Regulating Authority if any institution charge, collect or demand fees over and above the fees approved by the Fees Regulating Authority. Such complaints can be filed online through the Grievance portal of the Fees Regulating Authority. So also, the complaint can be made in writing with supporting documents to the Fees Regulating Authority.
10. If the fees approved by the Fees Regulating Authority is not acceptable to the Unaided Institutions whose fees has been determined by the Authority, then such Institutions may file the Review Application with detail reasoning thereof in detail within 15 days from the date of communication of the fees approved by the Authority.
11. The Review Application filed beyond the statutory period of 15 days to be treated as barred by limitation as provided u/s. 14 (1)(e) of the said Act of 2015 and same shall not be entertained.
12. The Review Application filed without pre-payment of processing of Rs. 50,000/- per course liable to be rejected.

Let the follow-up action be taken".

Respected Sir,

As per the above cited Subject & reference we hereby humbly state that we have submitted Online Application & Paid fee of Rs.50,000/\_ on dated:-08 August 2025 for review of our Final fees of Rs.1,76,000/\_ declared for the academic year 2025-26 which is being reduced by Rs.9,000/- as compared to Fee of Rs.1,85,000/\_ for the academic year 2024-25.

We most respectfully want to bring it to your kind attention that we have submitted tuition fee proposal during every academic year (as a sense of social commitment & considering adverse effects of Covid pandemic on income of every individual we have not submitted proposal for increase in tuition fee & decided to go with no upward version for the academic year 2021-22 which also have shown negative impact on at least annual 10% increase of our college Fee.) along with all details of income & expenditure as per the norms laid down by F.R.A., Mumbai; N.C.I.S.M., New Delhi; M.U.H.S., Nashik and Central/State Government authorities or other concern statutory bodies. Yet it has been observed that since last few years tuition fees of our college had been reduced in spite of our actual expenses because 60% to 70% significant staff salary increment is given during last four years & even during Covid Pandemic we have paid full salary without any deduction to Teaching-doctors & Non-Teaching or Hospital staff as reward for their consistent services). All the services of Sub-district Government hospital, Udgir were completely shifted in our institute so we have Freely provided all Physical facilities of college-Hospital building & instruments-equipment during Covid pandemic which has resulted huge damage/loss of our infrastructure so we have later on purchased it step by step at our own expenses & hence it too has shown 30% to 40% increase in our non-salary expenses during those subsequent years. However, there has been no substantial (at least 10%) increase in Tuition fee to that extent in the academic year 2022-23; 2023-24; 2024-25 & 2025-26.

We are selflessly working for Healthy citizen-Healthy society-Healthy Nation by organizing free diagnostic-Treatment-Awareness camp every week & one free Suvarna Prashan camp every month. Medical & surgical treatments performed in our hospital including food are Freely provided to needy & economically weak/poor patients. As compared to cost of surgery in private hospital, we are performing surgeries at our hospital with only 40% charges including medicines, etc. Various assistive devices(Ear Machine/Walker/Electric Chair /Spectacles) as per the requirement are distributed free of cost to Physically disabled persons. Free Nutritional food is also distributed to tuberculosis patients under NISHCHAYA Mitra scheme. Family planning surgeries are performed free of cost. Simultaneously as per the need we are always freely providing our infrastructure & staff services to Public Health Department, Govt. Of Maharashtra/India to implement various National Health Policies/Programs. We have observed that all these humanitarian activities are also playing a valuable role in practical knowledge & social responsibility amongst the students/staff.

Now we very politely want to bring it to your kind notice that since last few years during every Hearing of our institute it had been clearly informed that our expenses are genuine & it will be considered next year if separate report of college & hospital income-expenditure of last three years is submitted But yet after our submission on dated:-31/07/2025 it was suggested us that at one time Fee can't be increased by more than 10% & our institute is located in such a rural area where Farmer's are doing suicide. **Ours is the completely Teaching cum Charity Hospital (no Commercial Approach) providing health services (free medicine & food to poor & needy patients)** which all of you have categorically accepted during hearing of our review Application last year & assured us that our all submission will be considered during finalization of fee for Academic Year 2025-26. We are completely fed up & feel fully demoralized with the decision of decrease in our Tuition fee. It is also crystal clear direction that while finalizing Ad-hoc Fee of any institute their income-expenses(including Affiliation Fee / Permission Fee, etc. of university & state or central government) of last two years are taken in to consideration but it too has not been considered in our case.

As per information received from various new or old colleges(Medical, etc.) & after detail analysis of their computation sheet of last few years it has been observed that there is some disparity in consideration of salary & non-salary expenses of college-hospital(which may be technical error happened unknowingly & not the purposeful act to favor anyone) while deciding Tuition fee because every time the format of allowed & disallowed income-expenses has seemed to be changed even for the same institute also. As it is ideally & ethically not wise/good enough so we don't want & even like to reveal identity of these institute who have been either benefited or may have got justice while finalizing Tuition fee as per norms of F.R.A., Mumbai; N.C.I.S.M., New Delhi; M.U.H.S., Nashik/etc. But yet we are in complete dilemma why our actual income-expenses are being disallowed because your Assessment format-software is revealing our fee some thing else & while finalizing fee it too is not considered. Hence we think our review appeal must not only be considered while finalizing fee for academic year 2025-26 but also for previous year 2023-24 & 2024-25 (Just like policy adopted for new colleges while reconsideration of Ad-hoc Fee of last two year).

We honestly submit that N.C.I.S.M., New Delhi has directed(during 2022-2023) Ayurveda colleges to implement the Seventh Pay scale policy to all teaching staff but it is practically impossible to start it completely despite of the strong desire of any institution yet **we have started giving at least Basic salary of Seventh Pay scale since last year**. It is also difficult for us to provide annual salary increment to non-teaching-hospital staff & to make proper provision-adjustment of non-salary expenses to provide quality education to students & up-to-date excellent healthcare services to patients because college is facing huge financial problems. Hence if our actually paid staff salary/non salary expenses (through bank) are not considered then though we emotionally & professionally don't want to do any injustice with our Students-Parents, Teaching Staff / Non-Teaching-Hospital Staff & Society-Patients but we have no any other best alternative (option) except to seriously/ not intentionally & practically think (which we have avoided even during COVID pandemic) to immediately reconsider (may either revise completely or at least partially) our decision of 60 % to 70% salary increment given to staff during last four year & restrict all mandatory/needed expenditure to fulfil various best physical facilities for imparting updated/upgraded quality education to students & rendering best free health services to poor patients to avoid huge financial crises as it has become troublesome for all colleges to pay regular salaries to teachers or non-teaching-hospital staff and to meet other non-salary expenses. Because since last few years teaching institutes are facing serious issue of delayed disbursement(often pending for at least for two to three years) of scholarship to be paid to eligible students by Social Welfare Department & various concern government departments as educational fees, etc. which it may persist/continue in future also.

Lastly, We wholeheartedly request you to please consider our genuine factual submission on merit & accept review application of our college fees not only for academic year 2025-26 but also with its retrospective effect for academic year 2023-24 & 2024-25 just like Policy adopted for Ad-hoc Fee finalization & oblige our institute. Because it is not only essential for well being of Students-Parents(for imparting updated/upgraded quality education) & Society-Patients (rendering best free health services to poor/needy patients) but also useful for our honestly / regularly / properly working Teaching staff or Non-Teaching/Hospital staff to fulfill minimum expenses on basic needs (Education & Health along with Food, cloth & residence) of their First & second Heir Dependents.
