- 1. The competition is open only for Indian postgraduate scholars.
- 2. Participants are required to mandatorily fill the registration form link for consideration of the competition <u>https://forms.gle/niMEBrKxved12WtF9</u>. All participants must ensure that their details are furnished correctly as the same will be used for further communication by AIIA.
- 3. All the participants need to submit their article on the above link as an attachment in **downloadable A4 size PPT format.** Entries submitted through any other medium/mode would not be considered for evaluation.
- 4. The last date for the submission of the article is **20th December**, **2021** by **6:00 PM**. Any entries received after that will not be accepted for the Competition.
- 5. A participant can send only one entry. In case it is found that any participant has submitted more than one entry, all the entries will be considered as invalid for the said participant.
- 6. Mention of the author's name/emails, etc. anywhere in the poster will lead to disqualification.
- 7. The entry should be original. Copied entries will not be considered under the contest.
- 8. The participant must be the same person who has made the e-poster and plagiarism would not be accepted.
- 9. No co-authorship is allowed.
- 10. All India Institute of Ayurveda does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participants.
- 11. AIIA reserves the right to cancel or amend all or any part of the Competition and/ or the Terms & Conditions/Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria.
- 12. Any dispute or any issue related to this competition would be decided by All India Institute of Ayurveda only, which will be final and binding.
- 13. No requests relating to claims of re-evaluation of the entries will be considered. The decision of the committee will be final and binding to all the entries.
- 14. At any stage of evaluation, if an entry is found to violate the guidelines, the entry will be removed from evaluation process without giving any intimation.

- 15. The poster can be in English or Hindi or Sanskrit.
- 16. The poster is to be made in IMRD format with Introduction, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion Section mandatorily along with Conclusion.
- 17. The images and tables used in the poster should be numbered consecutively and should have a caption.
- 18. The references in the poster are to be mentioned as per appearance in article text in Vancouver style as numbers in superscript format after punctuation marks.
- 19. The references which are repeated in the poster must mention the original reference number inserted manually and superscripted.
- 20. Duplicity of referencing in reference list must be avoided.
- 21. The references are to be written in APA format. For Ayurveda books referencing style of Journal of Ayurveda Case Reports is to be followed. For more details the websites of <u>https://apastyle.apa.org/</u> or <u>www.ayucare.org</u> may be seen.
- 22. The e posters will be scored based on content, depth of research, presentation skill effectiveness, originality of ideas and analysis, referencing and novelty.
- 23. The organizers reserve the right to publish and disseminate e-poster submitted for the Competition.
- 24. Submission of the e-poster in this Competition shall constitute consent to such publication and dissemination.
- 25. A certificate of participation shall be e-mailed to all participants who have successfully submitted the article.

Prizes:

- First 3 Winners shall be awarded with cash prize and certificate

 - Second Prize Rs. 6000/-
 - Third Prize Rs. 4000/-
- Top 20 e-posters will be published in an e-book.
